Topic	Amazing Animals
Overview of topic	Finding out about different kinds of Animals- Jungle Animals. Farm Animals, Our Pets, Nocturnal Animals, Insects
Literacy focus	Books - Books about Animals (Fiction/Non-Fiction)_including Walking Through the Jungle/Rumble in the Jungle (Jungle Animals), I Love Animals/Farmer Duck (Farm Animals), Owl Babies (Nocturnal Animals) , Incey Wincey Spider/Mad About Mini Beasts (.Insects) Spot a Dog/Spot a Cat (Art Week)
Maths focus	Count objects to 10/20 and place numbers in order, Find 1 more/less than a number from 1 to 10. Beginning to use the language involved in adding /subtracting using Stem Sentences. Use familiar objects/common shapes to create patterns and build models. Use every day language related to size, weight capacity and time. Order and sequence familiar events.
Understanding The World	RE Special World: What is special about our world? Stories from different faiths about care for different animals. The World- Using Maps in Jungle Role Play, what do pets need? Farm Animals, Nocturnal Animals, Insects. Technology- Use camera to take photos of animals in Jungle Role Play, Take photos of animals at Cannon Hall Farm, Click and drag on computer to sort insects and match pets to their home..
Other learning Communication and Language	Through Role Play in our Jungle Role Play Area where the children can take on the role of Jungle Explorer and use language to describe different types of Jungle Animals...
Art and Design	Textiles- use collage materials to make pictures of animals, design and make a minibeast using a variety of materials. Experiment with a variety of Art techniques during Art Week.
PSED	Out and About - Safety in School and at home, Road Safety, Internet Safety.
Physical Development	Gymnastics- Linking movements, body shapes, sequences Games- Bat and ball skills. Pencil Control –Pen Pals Book 3 and activities. Curly Caterpillar letters Playdough – Enhanced Activities at Playdough Table to develop manipulative skills
Things to do at home	Take a photo of your pet and bring your photo into school to talk about. Make an information Poster about how to care for your pet.
