Our school is 50 years old this term. We will be helping the children to find out about the history of the school, and about the old school building before this school was built. Bikes / Scooters

There have been a few issues within the school grounds around children on bikes / scooters. Staveley Junior School and ourselves have both agreed that children should get off their bikes / scooters when they get inside the school gate and walk with them to park them in the storage area. Bikes / scooters are left at your own risk in the storage area. Please do not leave scooters / bikes in the entrance area to the school as this poses a risk in case of fire.

Headlice

We have had a few cases of head lice reported. Treat head lice as soon as you spot them. You should check everyone in the household and start treating anyone who has head lice on the same day. Children do not need to be kept off school if they have head lice. The first method to try is 'wet combing'. You can buy a special fine-toothed comb (detection comb) to remove head lice and nits. Wash hair with ordinary shampoo. Apply lots of conditioner (any conditioner will do). Comb the whole head of hair, from the roots to the ends. It usually takes about 10 minutes to comb short hair and 20 to 30 minutes for long, frizzy or curly hair. Do wet combing on days 1, 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched head lice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17.

No Smoking at the School Gates



As part of Derbyshire County Council's smoke-free gates initiative our children designed posters to discourage parents /carers smoking outside the school gates. Three posters designed by our children have been put up on the school gates at our main entrance on College Avenue and at the pedestrian entrance on Lime Avenue.
