Maths

White rose maths at home week 2 for year 1- learn all about capacity, as well as counting in steps of 10 and 2 - <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/>

Have a go at sharing objects or toys into equal groups- can you share numbers equally?

Can you do some Easter Maths?

How many eggs, bunnies or chicks can you count?

How many eggs can you get in a basket?



If you haven't any of these things to count you could draw some on paper and cut them out.

Could you make an Easter number hunt? - hiding numbers on pieces of paper to go and hunt for instead of chocolate eggs.

You could investigate how pairs of socks, or shoes you have in the house. Can you count them in 2's?

Literacy

Could you write your own adventure story for Peter Rabbit and his family?

When you are writing **remember**- Capital letters- finger spaces - full stops

He could have an adventure with the Easter Bunny. They could hide eggs in the wood for all the animals to find.

Can you make a list of the different animals that live in woods? What kind of homes do they have?

Could you draw a map of the wood and all the animals' houses? Make sure you put labels on them so we know who lives there.

Creative Activities

You could decorate an egg or make an Easter Bonnet. Get someone to take a photo of you so we can share them when we get back to school.
