This week I have been thinking about Summer day trips. One of my favourite stories is The Train Ride by June Crebbin. You can find it on YouTube. I love the pattern of the story. It is a great story to join in with.

Imagine you are going on a train journey. Where would you go and what would you see, draw a picture .

Use some junk modelling materials to make a train.

Trains sometimes make a ch ch ch sound, can you make it. Pretend to be a train, can you make different sounds, can you make it fast and slow, loud and quiet.

When the passengers are travelling on the train they see a tractor at the farm and a hot air balloon, draw or make a list of any other vehicles, how many can you think of. Go on a walk, how many vehicles can you see.

I hope that you have enjoyed some of the activities I have suggested like Dough Disco and sound games that we enjoy doing at Nursery.
