Maths

White Rose Maths Summer Term week 10 for year 1- learn about ordering bigger numbers and money. whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/

Make sure you are completing work in the White Rose workbooks from school.



Look at some coins. What is their value?

Can you find ways to make the same amount with different coins?

For example, ten 1p coins is the same as one 10p coin

Order your coins from largest to smallest.

Think about the terms- **less than**, **greater than**, and **equal to**. Use these terms to compare different coins.

Keep practising counting to 100 in ones, twos, fives and tens.

Literacy

We are looking at a historical story this week.

Here is the timetable showing you what we will be doing in school, you can also follow this at home.

Monday	Question words- Can we come up with questions to ask to find out about Grace Darling? Make sure we can read and spell the question words and can write a question mark.
Tuesday	Comparing the past with the present- writing sentences to describe how things in Grace Darling's time were different from today. Remembering capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
Wednesday	Drama - Act out the rescue story. Pretend it is the News report about the rescue. Could you think what Grace Darling would say to the news reporter?
Thursday	Writing a report- Can we look at the features of report writing and write a simple report of what happened?
Friday	Write your own rescue story about a boat getting in trouble on a stormy night at sea.

Investigating and Creating
