Hello children, I hope you are all well continuing to enjoy our home learning activities.



This week I have been looking at Pirate activities!

There are lots of Pirate stories you can read at home or find on YouTube. One of them is **Pirates Love Underpants** by Claire Freedman and Ben Cort. You could share the story together. You could make and design your own underpants, what pattern will you use - spots, stripes, hearts, flowers. Can you find any patterns around the house to talk about?

Find and share together other stories about Pirates.

Look in books or on the internet and find out about Pirates from the past. What did they look like? What did they do?

Make a pirate ship from junk materials around the house, what would be best, a cardboard box or plastic tub? Can you make it float in your bath?

Look at pictures of the 'Jolly Roger' flag, can you draw and make your own flag, what will you put on it?

How did pirates know where to find their treasure? Can you make a treasure map, can you make it look old? What will be on your map and where will you bury the treasure - inside a cave, under a palm tree, next to a big rock, behind a waterfall.

Use your map to play imaginary pirates, you could dress up like a pirate or make a pirate hat, patch and sword. What adventures will you go on?
