What is bullying?

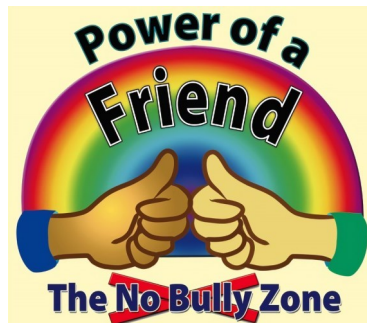
Hurting the same person on purpose lots of times.
